Driving Directions *from* Major Routes

I-75, North or South

1. Take **Exit 3 (Hopple Street)**. At end of ramp, turn left.
2. Turn left at the very next light - this is Central Parkway.
3. Approximately one mile out Central Parkway, drive past the first entrance to the college, then turn right, into the campus parking area and into Central Parkway Garage.
4. See “On Campus” notes below.

I-74, inbound to Cincinnati

- Take the Central Parkway exit.
- Turn left on College Drive.
- Follow campus directional signs to Visitors Parking in the Central Parkway Garage.
- *See On Campus notes below.*

On Campus

- We recommend parking in the garage.
- Take the garage elevator to level 5.
- Walk over to the ATLC (see the bookstore on that level).
- *Signs will point the way from here, but here's the rest:*
 - Take elevator (or stairs) up to the first floor.
 - Turn right (or if using stairs, go left), go through double doors to cafeteria.
 - Go to hallway on the right as you enter the cafeteria.
 - Go to Room 108, “The Point,” at end of that hallway.
