about this. The new text will officially take place on the First Sunday of Advent 2011, but can be implemented as early as the middle of next year. The new Mass parts will include such things as the Gloria, the Creed, new and revised Eucharistic Prayers, the Lamb of God and the prayer before the reception of Communion. In the coming months priests will be attending workshops on the new Mass parts and as they get them down, Fr. Mike will begin to slowly introduce them to us as part of the homily and as to why we are making changes. This may start in the mid to late fall. Once the official materials are printed we will also have handouts for you to take and study. This is going to be a learning process for all of us and once introduced, explained and studied, it should be easy.
