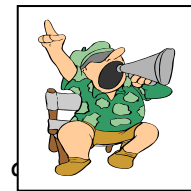
SUMMER BIBLE STUDY – *The Acts of the Apostles* –

- *Must be available the night of the show Saturday,
September 25th between the hours of 6-8:30PM.
- *Deadline for submissions is Monday, July 26th.
